### GOALS, OBJECTIVES, RECOMMENDATIONS, AND MEASURES

The Technical Committee suggested a number of changes to the Strategic Plan's goals, objectives/approaches, measurements and recommendations. In general, the Committee members called for measurements and recommendations to be edited and updated. Specific changes are grouped below for each goal.

1. Goal: Support new technologies and innovations in aviation.
  - a) In the first measurement, change "SATS technology" to "Next Generation technology".
  - b) Add a recommendation for FDOT to collect data on and prepare an inventory of airports with available infrastructure to support aircraft manufacturing and production.
  - c) In the third recommendation, change "Enterprise Florida" to "Florida State Chamber of Commerce".

2. Goal: Contribute to growth while remaining sensitive to the environment.

- a) Revise this goal to say, "Contribute to sustainable growth while remaining sensitive to the environment."
- b) Add these recommendations:
  - i) Support development of airport Sustainability Management Plans.
  - ii) Support development of airport Master Drainage Plans, but do not include this as a performance measure.

3. Goal: Provide efficient, safe and convenient airports.

- a) Add security to this goal, so that it says, "Provide efficient, safe, convenient, and secure airports."
- b) Change the recommendation on flight training to say, "Continue to work with flight training providers to ensure that their airspace and facility requirements are addressed, and help manage the distribution of training flights across airports regionally."
- c) Change the recommendation on coordinating with state economic development agencies to include providing an inventory of Florida airports with infrastructure capable of supporting aircraft manufacturing and production.

4. Goal: Enhance Florida's leadership and prominence in the aviation industry.

- a) Add an objective to encourage airports to implement sustainability planning.
- b) Add a recommendation to support dual-fuel systems and non-ethanol fuels at General Aviation airports.

5. Goal: Protect airspace and promote compatible land use planning around Florida airports.

- a) Add a recommendation to continue distributing and publicizing the Compatible Land Use Guidebook.

- c) Overall, strengthen the language in this goal to show a strong FDOT stance on land-use protection.
