

Existing Facilities

Facilities at the River Ranch Resort Airport include runway 16/34. Runway 16/34 is asphalt and measures 4,950 feet by 75 feet. It is also equipped with non-standard runway edge lights and is operational at night. The airport also includes a fixed base operator and a turnaround area at the arrival end of Runway 34. There is 100LL fuel available at the airport to serve the needs of transient and local aircraft.






Airport Classification



Twenty-three privately-owned aviation facilities are open to the public throughout Florida including River Ranch Resort Airport. These facilities generally comprise fly-in communities with grass strips or contain short paved runways that primarily serve the recreational general aviation public. Although these facilities are owned and operated by private individuals or companies, the facilities are open to the public for aviation use.






River Ranch Resort Airport caters to the GA needs of the community. The airport is located at a ranch resort and mainly accommodates recreational aviation. Its location allows pilots to fly in and enjoy the ranch's recreational activities. The airport also has fuel available onsite which allows visiting pilots to refuel before flying out.




Current and Forecast Demand

The River Ranch Resort Airport mainly serves recreational GA activity. As of 2014, there were 0 based aircraft and a total of 0 annual operations at the airport according to the Aviation Activity Forecast. The airport's airstrip can accommodate small GA aircraft and is also capable of accommodating helicopters. Economic Impact

River Ranch Resort Airport is approximately 98 miles south of Orlando. The airport has one paved and lighted runway that measures 4,950 feet. The airport accommodates small general aviation aircraft and helicopters. The airport primarily supports recreational flying and business activity. The airport is uniquely located at a ranch resort, which allows pilots to easily fly in and spend a few days enjoying the ranch's recreational activities, including horseback riding, airboat rides, and boat rentals. The airport also has fuel available onsite, which allows pilots to refuel before flying out.



Other Airport Characteristics

The River Ranch Resort Airport mainly accommodates GA recreational activities and pilots flying into the resort ranch. It also acts as a refueling station for transient aircraft.

Current and Future System Service Requirements/Recommendations

The airport provides Recreational/Sport services. As a privately owned airport, it is not well suited for providing any future services other than Recreational/Sport and this is supported by the scores shown in the analysis.
